DRAFT CIRCULAR

It is informed that the Ministry of Power (MoP), Govt. of India has launched the “**National Awareness Campaign – 2018**” to sensitize the children towards issues of energy conservation in the country by organizing a pan India Painting Competition on the subject.

The attention of the District Education Officers (DEO/DEEO)/District Project Officers (DPO) in the State is invited to the reference cited above. Painting Competition on Energy Conservation will be organized for **4th, 5th & 6th** standard students under **Group ‘A’** and for **7th, 8th & 9th** standard students under **Group ‘B’** in three levels i.e. **School, State & National Level**.

Details of Painting Competition on Energy Conservation are available in advertisement and websites www.bbmb.gov.in & www.beeindia.gov.in. All the DEO(s)/DEEO(s) and BEO(s)/BEEEO(s) are requested to circulate necessary instructions as per **Annexure-1 & 2** to schools situated in their respective District/Region of the State and ensure maximum participation to achieve desired objective.

Group wise Painting competition of 2 hours during July to 28th September 2018 may be organized under the supervision of school Head Master/Principal. Students may select any one of the following theme topics and use Pencil, Pencil Colours, Crayons and Water Colours to participate in the painting competition.

It is informed that all the participating students of School Level Painting Competition will get a ‘Certificate of participation’ and 1st & 2nd selected will get ‘Certificate of Merit’. An attractive cash prize for State and National Level Painting Competition are also given to the winners.

It is pertinent to mention that up to ten Officers from State Education Department & five officers from UT Education Department of the rank of DEO/DEEO or equivalent will be recognized by Govt. of India and Nodal Agency in the function for State Level Painting Competition and a certificate of Appreciation.

Further, necessary action with regard to uploading of copy of advertisement and instructions for schools at State education website may be facilitated.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE SCHOOL LEVEL PAINTING COMPETITION SCHEME

- a. School Level Painting Competition 2018 Group ‘A’ (4th, 5th & 6th standard students), Group ‘B’ (7th, 8th & 9th standard students) has been launched.
- b. School Principals are requested to organize painting competition of 2 hours duration at their respective Schools. Students can use any size of paper preferably A4 size (8.3x11.7 inches) (210mmx297mm) drawing sheet. Students can pick any one of the following Theme Topics:-

- c. The children can use Pencil, Crayons, Pencil Colours & Water Colours. The children may consider the following points while painting.
- Relevance of the theme depicting the selected topic
 - Execution of concept / theme.
 - Overall visual appeal, handling of given space and use of appropriate Colour combination.
- d. The respective school Principals will conduct the Painting competition for both A and B Groups separately at the school level.
- e. School principals will send the 2 best selected Paintings from Groups A and B separately to the Nodal Officer by **28th September, 2018**.
- f. School Principals to send the consolidated information about total participation of students for both A and B Groups separately at School level as per **Annexure -2 at following address.**

- g. The back of the paintings should carry the following information:

- h. All the participating students at School level painting competition will get a 'Certificate of Participation' and best 2 selected paintings will get 'Certificate of Merit' which will be signed by School Principal and Director General, Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power (Government of India).
- i. Paintings not signed by the school principal or sent directly by student's parents will not be accepted.
- j. Out of the total number of paintings sent by the respective school principals of the State/UT under Groups 'A' & 'B' after conducting School level Painting Competition, 50 paintings (plus 5 reserve) paintings each for Groups 'A' & 'B' will be selected by the respective selection committee/jury for State Level Painting Competition to be held on 14th Nov.,2018.
- k. 50 selected Students each for Groups 'A' & 'B' participating at State/UT Level Painting competition will be given **mementos, incentive of Rs.2000/- each & reimbursement of sleeper class/ AC Chair Car/ 3rd AC class rail fare or State Roadways bus fare from the shortest route for the student and two guardians per student for Group 'A' and one guardian for Group 'B'.**
- l. **Paintings are to be sent at the address of Nodal Officer only** and not on the addresses of Ministry of Power and Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE).
- m. It is to be mentioned that those schools who would record 100% participation in the Group 'A' (for the students of 4th , 5th & 6th standards) & Group "B" (7th,8th 9th standard students) at the School level Painting Competition, their names will be included in the Painting Competition booklet prepared by BEE.
- n. It is to be mentioned that up to ten Officers from State Education Department & five officers from UT Education Department of the rank of DEO/DEEO or equivalent who have cooperated and shown the best results, may also be recognized by presenting them mementoes and "Certificate of Appreciation" at State Level Painting Competition function on 14th November, 2018.
- o. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prize winners of both groups of the State Level Painting Competition will be invited to appear for National Level Painting Competition.
- p. The 1st /2nd/ 3rd Prize winners at State/UT level during the last two years (2016 & 17) of Group "A" and the 1st /2nd/ 3rd Prizes winners at State/UT level of previous year (2016 & 17) of Group "B" are not eligible to participate in this year i.e. 2018 competition. But the Consolation Prize winners of State/UT level of both groups are eligible to participate but they would be considered for prizes only if they secure 1st /2nd/ 3rd position.

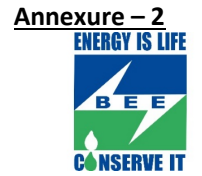
